1950 State Championship Football Reunion

The 1950 State Championship Football team held a 60th reunion of team members on November 5th, 2010 at Midway Point restaurant in Dallas. More than a dozen players attended the event. It was a chance to get together and recall some of the memories from that team. The 1950 team is the last DISD school to win a State Championship recognized by the UIL.

In the decade of the 1940's Sunset was a powerhouse in football, winning or sharing eight district titles and making the state finals in '42 & '49.

The prospects weren't looking good early in the 1950 season as Sunset's record stood at 2-2. But the Bisons proceeded to reel off seven straight wins, including the clincher over Houston Reagan at old Dal-Hi Stadium.

John Marshall, who was the fullback on the team said "At the end of 1950 our team could have beaten any team in Texas."

The Bisons were famous for running Coach Byron Rhome's "single wing, double wing & spinning T offense." But the secret to the Bison's success may have been their no-huddle offense. Fred Skidmore was the quarterback, who had been reading books supplied by an assistant coach, wanted to add plays. There wasn't time though. The Bisons center, the late Ivan Greenhaw, suggested they blow off the huddle and call plays under center, and always snap on two. The players didn't even tell the coach what they were planning.

When Coach Rhome saw it in action, he called a timeout and waved over his quarterback. "What are you doing?" asked the coach. Skidmore argued that the other team couldn't stop it. He must have made a good case because the no-huddle remained. Skidmore paid for it though. He had to run laps, during the game.

Alumni in the News: Sandy Holdcraft '68



Sandy Holdcraft, Haemovigilance Specialist, SHS Class of 1968

Patient Safety Champion Sandy Holdcraft in the Laboratory where she works as the hospital's Haemovigilance Specialist at Children's Medical Center in Dallas, one of only a handful who holds this position in the United States. As the specialist, Holdcraft ensures the safety of patients who receive approximately 15,000 blood component transfusions per year and the optimal use of blood products at Children's.

She is also responsible for the overall safety of patients who receive nearly 300 tissue transplants per year.

Sandy Holdcraft named as Patient Safety Champion. Sandy Holdcraft, RN, is first and foremost an advocate for patients and has been her entire career at Children's, which spans some 25 years. Today, she advocates for patient safety as it relates to blood transfusions and tissue transplants.

For her contributions to patient safety, Holdcraft was named the Patient Safety Champion for the fourth quarter of 2010 at a ceremony in her honor March 8th.

Said Holdcraft: "Our culture of safety must never cease to improve. It must be consistent and sustained from every corner of Children's and by all who work here. We must hold ourselves accountable for speaking up when we feel something could be done a safer way, when we differ with a colleague about an issue that should be investigated more to make sure all is safe and strive always to look for ways to improve education techniques that support the safest practices."

And she does a superb job of both. She promotes patient safety by using her strong relationships throughout the organization to discover potential problems and proactively address them through targeted educational efforts and performance improvements.

"Her consistently high degree of timeliness, comprehensiveness and professionalism with regard to patient safety issues are impeccably addressed and documented," says her supervisor, Jim Adams, senior director of Lab Operations. Congratulations to Sandy Holdcraft, SHS Class of '68.

The Sunset Varsity Cheerleading team won 1st place in the Six Flags Cheer Power Competition at Six Flags over Texas on April 30th, 2011.

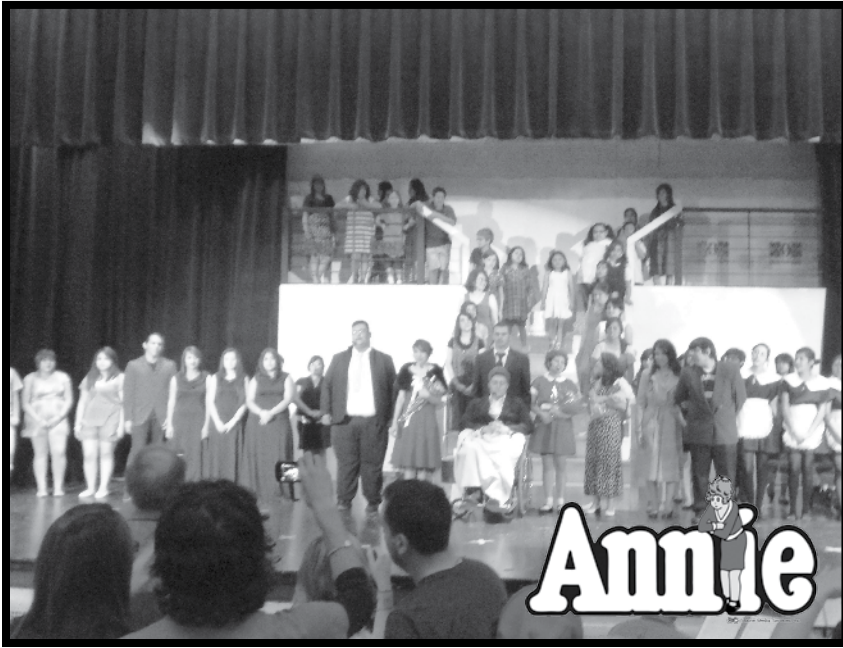
